Meet The Presenter: Dr. Jason Kirksey is the Vice President for Institutional Diversity and the Chief Diversity Officer at Oklahoma State University.

Dr. Kirksey serves as the principal investigator for the Oklahoma Louis Stokes Alliance for Minority Participation Program which is a \$3.4M, five-year NSF grant. With emphasis on increasing underrepresented minorities in STEM academi&c programs and graduates. Dr. Kirksey has 25 years of teaching experience, research, and active engagement with issues related to diversity and inclusion. Throughout his career, Dr. Kirksey has served on national and state-wide diversity boards and councils and, is a highly sought consultant and speaker. He holds a BA in both Political Science and Economics, and an MA in Political Science from OSU. He earned his Ph.D. in Political Science from the University of New Orleans. In November, 2018, Dr. Kirksey received the 2018 Distinguished Service Award from the Association of Public Land Grant Universities Commission on Access, and has received many awards during his career.
